GOOD READ: Author Timothy Good believes aliens have been on earth longer than humans

MoD intelligence reveals UFO sightings

AN EXPERT on alien phenomena has uncovered top-secret documents and sightings by high-ranking military personnel and intelligence insiders for his new book.

Timothy Good's *Need to Know - UFOs, the Military and Intelligence*, is full of revelations and apparent evidence about the existence of extraterrestrials.

Paul Hellyer, a former Canadian minister of defence, states in the book's forward: "UFOs are as real as the airplanes that fly over your head... The time has come to lift the veil of secrecy and let the truth emerge."

According to Mr Good, the truth is out there and some of his research is based on recently declassified official military documents from countries around

the world including Britain and America.

It may seem like something out of an episode of the X-Files but the bodies of aliens and their spaceships are being kept in top-secret facilities by the US military, he claimed.

The bestselling author, who lives in Bromley, thought it was likely there are different species of aliens and some that look similar to us.

He said: "I think they come from a number of different sources, I do not think they are restricted to planets because they have enormous ships acting as bases.

"They have actually have been on this planet for a great deal longer than we have, which would explain a lot of what is going on.

"People from all walks of life, including military and scientific, say they were responsible for genetically upgrading primitive man on this planet."

He said their genetic link to humans could explain their "humanoid" appearance.

For decades, governments around the world have hidden knowledge of alien life-forms and intelligence from the general public, he said.

"It is a very real and serious problem for governments worldwide. What I have shown in the book is that from the 1940s there was a conflict situation.

Attack

"The Americans started shooting at some of these [alien] crafts and succeeded in knocking a few out of the sky in late June 1947.

"This is officially confirmed in secret documents shown in the book," the 65-year-old said.

The attack by the US led to series of aviation disasters worldwide with strong evidence linking them to alien retaliation, he said.

Asked how he uncovered these incidents, Mr Good said: "By freedom of information requests in the US and Britain, a lot of stuff has been released by the Ministry of Defence.

"There are thousands of pages of official documents on UFOs. But the most sensitive stuff is still being withheld."

Interviewing military and civilian pilots, naval officers and intelligence agency staff has led to many insights into alien activity, he said.

However, he said he was extremely careful to check his sources as 95 per cent of

Mr Good used the example of the recent media coverage of glowing orange lights spotted in the skies around Tunbridge Wells that many claimed could only be evidence of extraterrestrial activity, which turned out to be coloured lanterns released as part of wedding celebrations.

So what do real alien space-craft look like?

He said: "They come in many different sizes. The smallest are the size of a grapefruit, which are remote-controlled probes.

"The largest can be several miles big. In March 1997 in Phoenix, Arizona, a craft at least a mile in length was seen.

"Recently the Governor of Arizona, who at the time blew off the alien deal saying it was all nonsense, only this year came out and said he saw a giant triangular craft and as far as he was concerned it was alien."

He added how in the same year a journalist on the Folkestone Herald claimed she had seen a giant triangular craft in the Romney Marsh area making an extraordinary sound.

He said presidents and prime ministers were often kept in the dark over interplanetary communication and that information was released to even them on a need-to-know basis.

"As a writer and investigator I remain healthily sceptical even about my own sightings.

"It can take years to get to know a source and you get false information, especially with ex-military and intelligence personnel," Mr Good added.

A spokeswoman for the MoD said in response to Mr Good's claims: "The MoD has no interest or role with respect to the question of the existence or otherwise of extraterrestrial lifeforms.

"The MoD does not carry out research into UFO matters. Unless there is evidence of a potential threat, there is no attempt to identify the nature of sightings reported."
